

Camping Checklist

IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ: Everything, except personal toiletry items (toothbrush, deodorant, etc.), needs to be brought to the Wednesday night meeting the week of the camping trip. You will need to bring your personal toiletry items with you on Thursday or Friday (the day we leave) and pack them in your backpack/camelback bag you will be taking with you in the vehicle. Make sure all items have your name on them and packed in one bag that is 30" or less.

	Bible
	Sleeping bag (Bring in large cloth laundry bag w/sleeping pad if bringing one)
	Sleeping pad OR sleeping cot (Bring sleeping pad in large cloth laundry bag w/sleeping bag)
	Sleeping Cot (Pack separately in its own bag. The size needs to be 72"L X 35"W x 17"H)
	Camping Chair - if you don't bring one, you won't have anything to sit on
	Pillow (Bring in large cloth laundry bag w/sleeping pad & bag if you don't want to ride w/it or have it in personal bag)
	Flashlight that works (extra batteries and bulb)
	Coat or jacket (the evening programs tend to be cooler)
	Warm hat, gloves or mittens, scarf (winter camping)
	Poncho, rain suit or umbrella (REQUIRED - Pathfinders are always prepared)
	Casual clothes (jeans, t-shirts (short & long sleeve), shorts, etc.) for each day; running attire (gym shorts for 5K races (for camporees). (Shorts need to be as long as the tips of your fingers & no tank tops for girls)
	Something warm to sleep in
	Club t-shirt – one for each day. This year's shirt colors are still to be determined
	Two pairs of shoes (hiking and/or tennis) AND 3 grocery store plastic bags to put dirty shoes in
	Flip Flops for showers (Mandatory)
	Socks for each day- plus one
	Underwear for each day – plus one
	Dirty clothes bag and 2 grocery store bags for wet items.
	Personal items (deodorant, chapstick, comb, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
	Bath towel, washcloths
	Shampoo & soap
	Baby wipes - for when the showers may not be accessible
	Bug spray
	Sunscreen
	Refillable water bottle
	Hot drink mug- must have if you would like hot chocolate/apple cider, <u>we do not have cups for hot drinks</u>
	Hat for sun protection and/or warmth
	Daypack (Camelbak) for day hikes-to carry personal items around camp (it's nice if it's a hydration pack)
	Large black plastic bag to put ALL personal stuff in it case it rains
	For Camporees that require Class A uniform <input type="checkbox"/> Scarf & Slide, <input type="checkbox"/> Sash, <input type="checkbox"/> Black pants, <input type="checkbox"/> Black shoes, <input type="checkbox"/> Black socks, <input type="checkbox"/> Shirt <input type="checkbox"/> Black belt. Please bring on hanger protected by trash bag or hanger bag. Please have your name written on it somewhere.
	Optional Items below:
	Camera
	Sunglasses

Items to leave at home:

	Food (this means all snacks! NO FOOD WILL BE ALLOWED IN TENTS)
