

## Pathfinder Tenting Options

Camping events this year will be a bit different regarding the tent capacity situation. Due to concerns of the public surrounding physical distancing we are offering a few different options. The options listed below will be the **ONLY** options available for overnight camping this year. See (\*) below for more information. Please select **ONE** option for your child:

\_\_\_\_\_ Keep the tenting situation as it has been in the past, with 3 pathfinders in a tent. I understand my child will not be able to wear face coverings, and physical distance cannot be guaranteed.

\_\_\_\_\_ I would like to “rent” a single-person tent for my child to use while camping with the club. I understand that choosing this option means my child will not be able to enter friends’ tents at all, even for socializing. I understand that my child will be using a tent purchased by the club and not purchasing their own tent, this way uniformity in appearance and tent quality can be maintained. These tents will not be large enough to be able to use a cot. I understand my child will still have to abide by the “buddy-system”, meaning they will need to wake someone up in another tent if they need to use the restroom after bedding down for the night. The cost of this “renting” will be one third of the cost to purchase the tent and footprint (\$35-\$60 non-refundable fee for the year).

\_\_\_\_\_ I do not wish to allow my child to participate in overnight camping events this year.

\*Considering the amount of time and energy it requires to operate these overnight events, there is no option for “day participation”. By this we mean dropping your Pathfinder off, allowing them to participate in the events of the club, but then picking them back up in the evening so they are not participating in the overnight portion. This creates a large disruption in the event, and makes it exceedingly difficult to plan for transportation, meals, and security issues. Thank you for understanding.
